WAALITJ FACTION

Gold faction is known as Waalitj which is the Noongar name for Eagle. Historically, the Wedge Tail Eagle was often seen in the Perth Hills area. Their population is now in decline, and they have become a protected species.



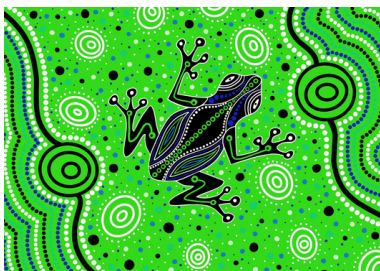
QUENDA FACTION

Our red faction is named Quenda which is the Noongar name for the Southern Brown Bandicoot. There is a population of Quenda which reside on the banks of Bennett Brook, relishing the density of the wetland vegetation as it's habitat.



YOORN FACTION

Our purple faction is named Yoorn which is the Noongar name for the Bobtail lizard. These lizards are widespread and common throughout the Perth region and are well known to venture into homes and gardens in the Caversham area.



KOoyAR FACTION

Our green faction is named Kooyar, which means frog in the Noongar language. Motorbike frogs are plentiful in the Caversham area which is bordered by Bennett Brook and the Swan River. In the evening, Caversham residents are often entertained by the sound of Motorbike frogs calling at night.
